Danielle, who plays the character Bea in the television series *Wentworth*, has been nominated in the 'Most Outstanding Actress' category. The Logies ceremony will be held on 3 May 2015.

Earlier this month, Danielle won 'Most Outstanding Performance By An Actor-Female' in the ASTRA Awards.
