SHINE for Kids

What is Scale

Rise is a mentoring program for primary-aged children with a parent in custody delivered in school. The program is designed to support children's emotional and social wellbeing and encourage positive engagement with their school communities.



What's involved?

Children receive weekly one-on-one support from a dedicated and trained Rise mentor with weekly sessions during school hours for the duration of a year.

The program involves a series of structured activities which provide students with the tools they need to become resilient, confident, and future-focused young people.



Why is this program needed?

Children with a parent in custody often experience change and stress in their family life, making it hard to focus at school. They might change schools or move house and feel stigmatised and disconnected from their peers and communities.

A consistent positive adult role model promotes wellbeing by giving children the emotional and social tools to engage with their peers and education. The program may also support increased school attendance and decrease anti-social behaviour.



Who is eligible?
