The first time you go to see mum or dad, **it might be a bit strange**. There will be lots of people in uniforms that are working. They are there to help you have a good visit.



Sometimes there are dogs

They are friendly but **you can't pat these dogs** as they are doing an important job smelling everyone to make sure everything is safe.

Toilet time

Do you need to go? Make sure you tell the grown-up you are with if you need to go to the toilet **BEFORE you see mum or dad!**



The locker

Before you see mum or dad, you will get a special box. It's really important that you **put everything you have** with you in this box.

The big gate

You'll walk through a big gate and the people who work there might wave a wand over your clothes.



The big loud doors

Before you can see mum or dad you'll need to **go through some big heavy doors**. They might make a bang sound but don't worry.

The Visits Room

You and the grown-up you are with will get a special table to sit at and wait for mum or dad. **Mum or dad are on their way!**



Seeing mum or dad!

When mum or dad arrive, you can **give them a big cuddle** and tell them about your day! Mum or dad will be wearing a uniform and will look the same as lots of the other grownups in the room. Just like a football team!

A special box for mum or dad

Maybe you can **keep a special box** with your best art and craft to show them when they come home too?

It's a long time sitting down! Don't worry if you need to have a wiggle, **you can pop over and have a play or draw some pictures with SHINE** (we have purple t-shirts!). We have a special area just for kids in the room. You can even draw mum or dad a picture to put up in their room!

Saying goodbye

We know you miss mum or dad and **saying goodbye is really really hard**. It's ok. Remember they are safe and you'll get to see them again soon. And you can always speak to them on the phone and send them letters and craft to show them that you miss them.
